- Distinguished Professor of international relations and diplomacy at the International Christian University (ICU), Tokyo, Japan
- Former Ambassador and Permanent Representative of Japan to the United Nations
- 1969: Graduated from LeRoy High School in LeRoy, Illinois, USA by American Field Service Scholarship program
- 1974: Graduated from the ICU in Tokyo and joined the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Japan.
- Served in both Ministry of Foreign Affairs in Tokyo as well as Japanese Embassies and Missions abroad; Spain, Argentina, UK, OECD in Paris, Thailand, and the United Nations (UN) in NY.
- 2006-2016: Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of Japan to Spain, Japan's first Special Representative for Afghanistan and Pakistan, Ambassador and Permanent Representative to the OECD in Paris, and Ambassador and Permanent Representative of Japan to the UN.
- Speaks Japanese, English, Spanish and French.
- He is married and has two adult sons.
- Has received decorations from Argentina, Mongolia, Morocco and Spain.
