Category	Questions	Answers
Attendance	If I have a prior engagement on the day of the ceremony and cannot attend, do I need to notify someone?	It is not necessary to provide any notification that you will not be attending. However, if you are a valedictorian or if you have been selected to represent your school, please follow the instructions previously provided and contact the relevant office to inform them you cannot attend.
Bags and belongings	I will have a suitcase with me on the day of the ceremony. Is there a place where I can stow it?	An area for stowing belongings will be available for the Graduation Ceremony in the 70th Anniversary Auditorium. Note that the Entrance Ceremony will NOT have an area to stow belongings, so please plan accordingly.
Guest seating	Can my family or guests attend the ceremony? If so, will they be able to join me in the same venue as the students?	Most seats in the 70th Anniversary Auditorium are reserved for students, so only a small number of remaining seats for families and guests may be available. If those seats are filled, families and guests may be asked to relocate to the alternate venue in the Multi-Purpose Digital Hall, where they may view a live broadcast of the ceremony.
Online streaming	Will the ceremonies be streamed on YouTube?	There are no plans to stream the ceremonies online.
