- Mass evacuation
- Setting up of emergency response headquarters
  Location: the wooden deck in front of Suzukake Hall
- Formation of a Disaster Response Team for each building (at its designated evacuation assembly area)
- Confirmation of safety and headcount of evacuees
- Reporting the safety and number of evacuees

Held in the vicinity of the School of Life Science and Technology

- First aid skills (H1 & H2 Bldgs.)
- Making a 119 call for emergency assistance (H1 & H2 Bldgs.)
- Use of indoor fire hydrant systems (B1B2 Bldg.1F)
- Use of water fire extinguishers (B1B2 Bldg.)
- Smoke-simulation house (B1B2 Bldg.)
  (canceled in the event of rain)
- Distribution of emergency food (B1B2 Bldg.1F)
  Starts at 15:15 While supplies last
