発熱、咳、咽頭痛等の症状があり、新型コロナウイルス感染症を疑う場合、PCR 検査や抗原 検査を受ける場合、濃厚接触者になった場合、同居者が体調不良や濃厚接触者になった場合は、 下記の通り対応してください。

- 大学が指示する期間は出校を控えてください。
- 『濃厚接触』に相当する行動は控えてください。 マスクを外す、距離が近い、長時間、換気不良下で接触しないこと。

## 1. 相談

「体調不良になった場合]

- 2. 出校停止、学内関係者への連絡・報告
  - ●自身または同居者の状況を、下記の対応フローで確認し、出校停止、連絡・報告等について 対応してください。

●特に、**自身の PCR 検査結果が陽性**の場合、**自身が有症状の濃厚接触者**となった場合は 【COVID19 報告書】 <a href="https://www.titech.ac.jp/student-support/file/covid19-jp.xlsx">https://www.titech.ac.jp/student-support/file/covid19-jp.xlsx</a> を必ず pcrtest@jim.titech.ac.jp に提出してください。

これまでの対応との主な変更点は以下のとおりです。(詳細は上記フロー図で必ず確認)

- ▶ 陽性者本人から、濃厚接触者(相当)に連絡
- ▶ 濃厚接触者の範囲を、マスクをしないで会話・食事した者、同居している者に再定義
- ▶ pcrtest@jim.titech.ac.jp への報告書の提出対象を、陽性者又は有症状の濃厚接触者に限定

[出張に伴う PCR 検査や、帰省や手術前のため予備的に PCR 検査を受ける場合]

・報告は不要です。

ただし、予備的 PCR 検査の結果「陽性」となった場合は、速やかに上長及び専用アドレスに報告してください。

What You Should Do When You or Someone You Live With Is Suspected to Be COVID-19 Positive, Undergoes PCR or Antigen Testing, or Is Identified as a Close Contact

Please be sure to follow the instructions below when you have COVID-19-like symptoms such as fever, cough, sore throat; when you undergo PCR or antigen testing; when you are identified as a Close Contact; or when someone you live with is unwell or is identified as a Close Contact:

- Do not come to campus for the period designated by the Institute.
- Refrain from actions that may be considered close contact with others (meeting
  without wearing a face mask, being in close proximity for an extended time or in spaces
  without sufficient ventilation, etc.).

## 1. Consultation

If you develop symptoms:

• First contact your family doctor, local clinic, or the Consultation Center for the People with Potential 2019-nCOV Exposure (帰国者・接触者相談センター) in your prefecture by telephone to ask for instructions.

- 2. Staying away from campus, required reporting
- Check the manual below, referring to the sections that apply to you and the person you live with, and follow the relevant procedures such as staying away from campus and reporting your circumstances to relevant parties.

In particular, those who test positive or are identified as a Close Contact with symptoms must fill out the report available from the link below and submit it to pcrtest@jim.titech.ac.jp.

Key changes from the previous response are as follows. Be sure to check the above manual for full details.

- Those who test positive should contact anyone with whom they may have had close contact.
- A "Close Contact" has been redefined as someone who has had conversation or has dined with a COVID-19 patient without wearing a face mask, and any individual living with a COVID-19 patient.
- Only a) those who test COVID-19 positive and b) Close Contacts with symptoms are required to submit a report to pcrtest@jim.titech.ac.jp.

The content of the report will be shared with those involved to the extent deemed necessary in accordance with the School Health and Safety Act, in order to prevent secondary infections and continue educational and research activities at the Institute. In such cases, the information will be strictly managed, with due consideration of the rights and privacy of the concerned individuals.

If you undergo PCR or antigen testing as a precaution before a business trip, visiting family, or undergoing surgery:

You do not have to report it to the Institute. However, if you test positive, you must immediately inform your supervisor and report it to the designated address (pcrtest@jim.titech.ac.jp).
