Philosophy for Children (p4c) has been adopted in education for younger children as an innovative way to foster reasoning and argumentation skills. This approach has been applied in a variety of settings, not only in early education, but also in adult groups as a way to create a safe intellectual space where participants explore issues of interest together. In this class we introduce p4c, its tools for facilitating thought process with groups, and examples of it in practice. After that the participants will make questions to explore in the group with some prompt materials, and engage in p4c dialogue.

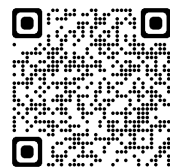
