Candidates: The main applicant shall be Tokyo Tech students

*Both individual and team applications are acceptable; non-Tokyo Tech students (e.g. from other universities and/or even non-students) can also join in case of a team application.

Name of this Project: Students' Startup Support Program by Tokyo Institute of Technology Fund Supporting Period: April 2022 – February 2023

POCX Supporting Amount: shall be determined based on the application (the supporting amount may differ from the amount you applied)

Max. 1,000,000 JPY support for a single application (of a significantly excellent idea and business plan of high degree of completion)

Normally 300,000 JPY support for a single application (of a good idea and business plan of high growth potential)

Support money for POC (Proof of Concept):

- materials costs for prototyping costs for market survey travel expenses for attending other pitch competitions, etc.
 Your supervising professor shall be your budget manager of the support money provided, who shall also sign your application form.
- For B1-B3 students, Industrial Cooperation Division shall be your budget manager.
- For using the support money, the purpose should be precisely reported. The settlement shall be carried out upon each payment.
- Expensive equipment and systems shall be managed as Tokyo Tech's assets. They shall be returned to Tokyo Tech after usage.
