Outline LIYSF is a two week-long event mainly held at Imperial College London, with lectures and demonstrations from leading scientists, visits to industrial sites, research centres, scientific institutions and organisations, including world class laboratories and universities. LIYSF attracts approximately 500 of the world's leading young scientists aged 16-21 years old from about 70 countries.

- Second year undergraduate student or above at Tokyo Tech.
  - Date of birth must be after 24<sup>th</sup> July 1997.
  - Have a good understanding of English.
  - Studying or researching in the field of science.
  - Pass an internal selection interview (please see “10. Selection By Tokyo Tech”).
- \* Students taking a leave of absence from Tokyo Tech are basically ineligible to apply. Please consult with the International Student Exchange Division in advance if you wish to apply.
- \*Must be a regular student (in a degree program) of Tokyo Tech.
5. Number of Nominees Approximately 5 students
6. Fee Participation fee is £1,995 per student (to be paid by the participant)  
\*The fee covers the total cost of the programme over 15 days; all meals and accommodation, lectures and demonstrations, scientific visits and entrance charges, travel to all programmed events and the social programme. ~~The fee does not cover airfare, crisis management and travel insurance fee, costs relating to VISA application, optional sightseeing tours, theatre tickets, etc.~~
