



APRU -AEARU Multi-Hazards Summer School 2019

Call for Application

1. Outline	<p>The 7th APRU Multi-Hazards Summer School will be held in Japan July 22 to 25 at Tohoku University in collaboration with academic consortium AEARU*. This year's theme is "Supporting the interface between science and policy for decision making in disaster risk reduction (DRR)." Participants will understand the mechanism of international DRR strategy, learn from the experience and recovery process of the 2011 Great East Japan Earthquake and Tsunami, learn from various DRR projects implemented in the Tohoku region and overseas, and discuss the roles of science, technology, and universities in the implementation of the Sendai Framework for Disaster Risk Reduction.</p> <p>* Established in 1996, the Association of East Asian Research Universities (AEARU) is a consortium that promotes exchange and cooperation activities between member universities, including Tokyo Tech.</p>

3. Venue	IRIDes, Tohoku University (Sendai City, Miyagi Prefecture, Japan)
4. Eligibility	Tokyo Tech graduate students
5. Number of nominees	2 students from Tokyo Tech will be nominated to participate
6. Fees and Financial Support	There is no participation fee, and accommodation in Sendai will be provided for Tokyo Tech's nominees. However, participants will be responsible for their own transportation to/from Sendai and other personal expenses. A stipend to cover some expenses may be provided by Tokyo Tech.
