Tokyo Tech students are invited to participate in Global Entrepreneurship Camp 2017 organized by KAIST. Please note that after applicant interviews conducted in English, Tokyo Tech will nominate one student to participate in the program. The program is conducted for students of partner universities of KAIST.

1. Outline The 10-day program consists of lectures, workshops, special talks, tech tour, cultural trip and demo day relating to entrepreneurship activities. 35 students from 11 partner universities of KAIST including DTU, EPFL, ETH and so on.
