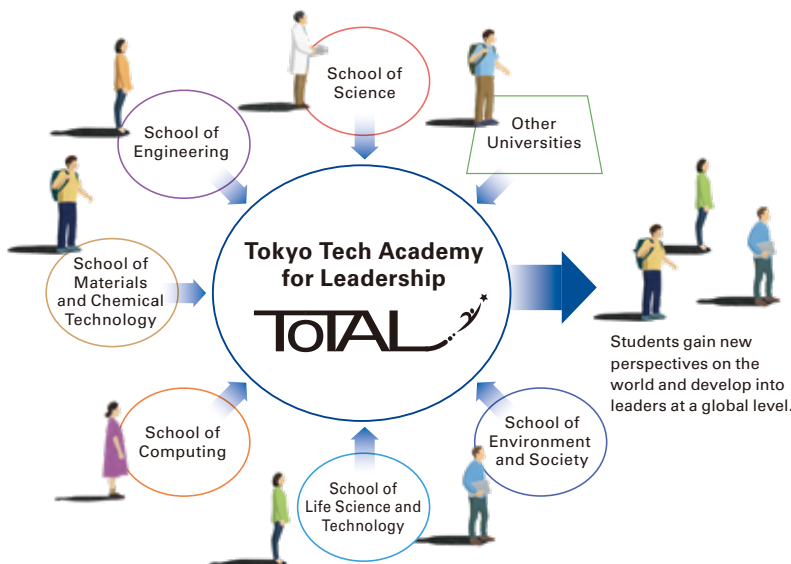

- ⑤ Financial support is provided in the form of travel expenses for the Off-Campus Project, tuition exemption, and scholarships.

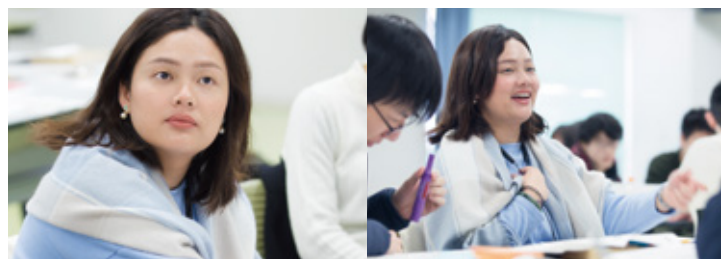
## Student Reflections
