Subject: Reopening of Campus Facilities for Extracurricular Activities

As part of preventive measures against COVID-19, Tokyo Tech closed on-campus facilities for extracurricular activities. As the alert level will be lowered from 2+ to 2-, student clubs and groups will be allowed to use outdoor facilities, subject to certain restrictions, starting from September 9.

Please adhere to the rules and instructions below, and strictly observe safety precautions.

1. Facilities to reopen under alert level 2-

Outdoor facilities (i.e., multipurpose field, handball court, and tennis courts)

(Tennis courts on Ookayama campus will be available for official student clubs and groups only.)

Indoor facilities remain closed for extracurricular activities.

2. Reservation of facilities

Tokyo Tech will resume accepting reservations on September 9, 2020.

Note: Some official student clubs and groups have already obtained permission to use the relevant facilities upon approval by a vice president in charge.

3. Do not use campus facilities in the following cases

You have any of these symptoms:

- fever above 37.5 degrees Celsius or temperature higher than usual
- coughing, sore throat, and/or other cold-like symptoms
- fatigue and/or breathing difficulties
- loss of taste and/or smell

You might have been exposed to coronavirus because:

- you had close contact with someone diagnosed with COVID-19.
- you were around family members or someone with suspected infection.

4. Rules

Please observe the following:

- Limit reservation requests to no more than two hours at a time per group (except for official clubs and groups). The number of participants must be 10 or less.
- Prepare a participant list and keep a record of whether or not members have any symptoms or possible exposure (see section 3 above).
- Avoid gatherings or events involving group meals.
