

AY 2018 Disaster Drill at Suzukakedai Campus

Date: Wednesday, November 14, 2018

Start time: 12:15

Program: 1. Comprehensive drill based on a scenario in which an earthquake with a seismic intensity of 6 strikes the campus.

2. Optional training activities.

Objective: Coordinated execution of disaster relief operations by Disaster Response Teams and their subgroups.

Comprehensive Drill (12:15–12:45)

Students, faculty, and staff are all expected to attend.

- Mass evacuation
- Setting up of emergency response headquarters
Location: the wooden deck in front of Suzukake Hall
- Formation of a Disaster Response Team for each building (at its designated evacuation assembly area)
- Confirmation of safety and headcount of evacuees
- Reporting the safety and number of evacuees



Optional Training Activities (13:00–15:10)

Held in the vicinity of the Laboratory for Future Interdisciplinary Research of Science and Technology.

- First aid skills
- Making a 119 call for emergency assistance
- Use of indoor fire hydrant systems
- Use of water fire extinguishers
- Smoke-simulation house (canceled in the event of rain)
