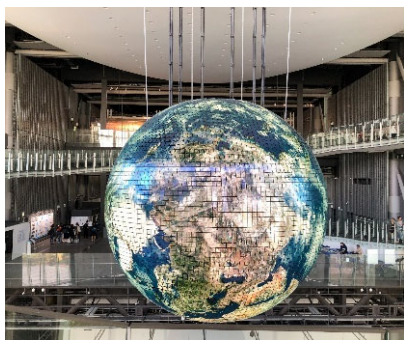


# Technology for Sustainable Food

Maximum 20 in total, including up to 10 from Tokyo Tech

*In the case of oversubscription, participants will be competitively selected.*
