When accepting visitors or holding events involving non-Tokyo Tech members, appropriate preventive measures must be taken corresponding to the respective alert levels for “11. Gatherings and Events” and “12. Visitors to Tokyo Tech campuses” specified in the Tokyo Tech Response.

To all visitors

- Make sure you do not have any symptoms of sickness when visiting.
- Please avoid coming in large groups.
- Make sure to take infection prevention measures, washing hands, and using sanitizer.
- Those visiting as a group are expected to avoid conversations as much as possible.
- Those coming to view campuses prior to admission, etc. are not allowed to enter buildings on Tokyo Tech premises.
