

Global Scientists and Engineers Course – Advanced Designated Courses and Completion Requirements

Entry requirements:

- 1) A graduate of Tokyo Tech who successfully completed the previous GSEC (before March2017) or current GSEC – Intermediate
 - 2) A graduate of another university who has acquired basic global competencies and achieved the minimum test score or fulfilled the requirements of one of the following:
TOEFL iBT: 80 points, **TOEFL ITP:** 550 points, **TOEIC:** 750 points, **IELTS:** 6.0 points, **EIKEN:** Grade Pre-1
- The Application Form must be submitted along with a photocopy of the Official Score Report of one of the above-mentioned tests and one of the following:
 - documentation (certificates, etc.) proving that the applicant has the same level of global competencies as those who have completed GSEC – Intermediate
 - an essay describing how the applicant possesses the global competencies necessary to enroll in GSEC – Advanced
 The screening results will be notified via email after applications and necessary documents have been reviewed.

GSEC – Advanced aims to provide education, including study abroad programs, that enables students to develop the following:

- (1) International liberal arts
 The comprehensive perspective required of a global scientist/engineer as well as broad knowledge that enriches communication on the global stage by deepening understanding of subjects such as ethics, history, culture, and literature
- (2) Global leadership
 Skills such as developing objectives, increasing team members motivation, and managing projects based on concrete plans
- (3) Skills to bring new ideas and values
 Developing new and international perspectives free from traditional convention, and acquiring creative skills and values that will bring up new ideas and proposals for individuals and organizations
- (4) Basic skills to conduct international joint research
 PDCA (plan-do-check-act) in order to bring new proposals for enhancement of society by working with experts from diverse fields while exercising one's own expertise

Students must attain 4 credits from the courses on the completion requirements list, and study abroad experience for at least 8 consecutive weeks (minimum 40 study days).

GSEC acknowledges the acquisition of international experience as one of Tokyo Tech's key goals in education. After fulfilling the completion of GSEC – Intermediate, students will have gained the following through international experience:

- a broader perspective
- an appreciation of diversity and collaboration with people from other countries
- improved communication skills in foreign languages

Notes:

- The number of courses designated for GSEC will increase.
- Students should register for courses in such a way to acquire (a) international liberal arts, (b) international leadership, (c) skills to bring new ideas and values, and (d) basic skills for conducting international joint research.
- Students will be assessed on the competencies recorded in their learning portfolios and will undergo interviews in order to fulfill the completion requirements. Those who have been admitted will receive the Certificate of Completion upon finishing a master's program.
- Mentors and program coordinators give instructions as necessary to students enrolling in GSEC.
