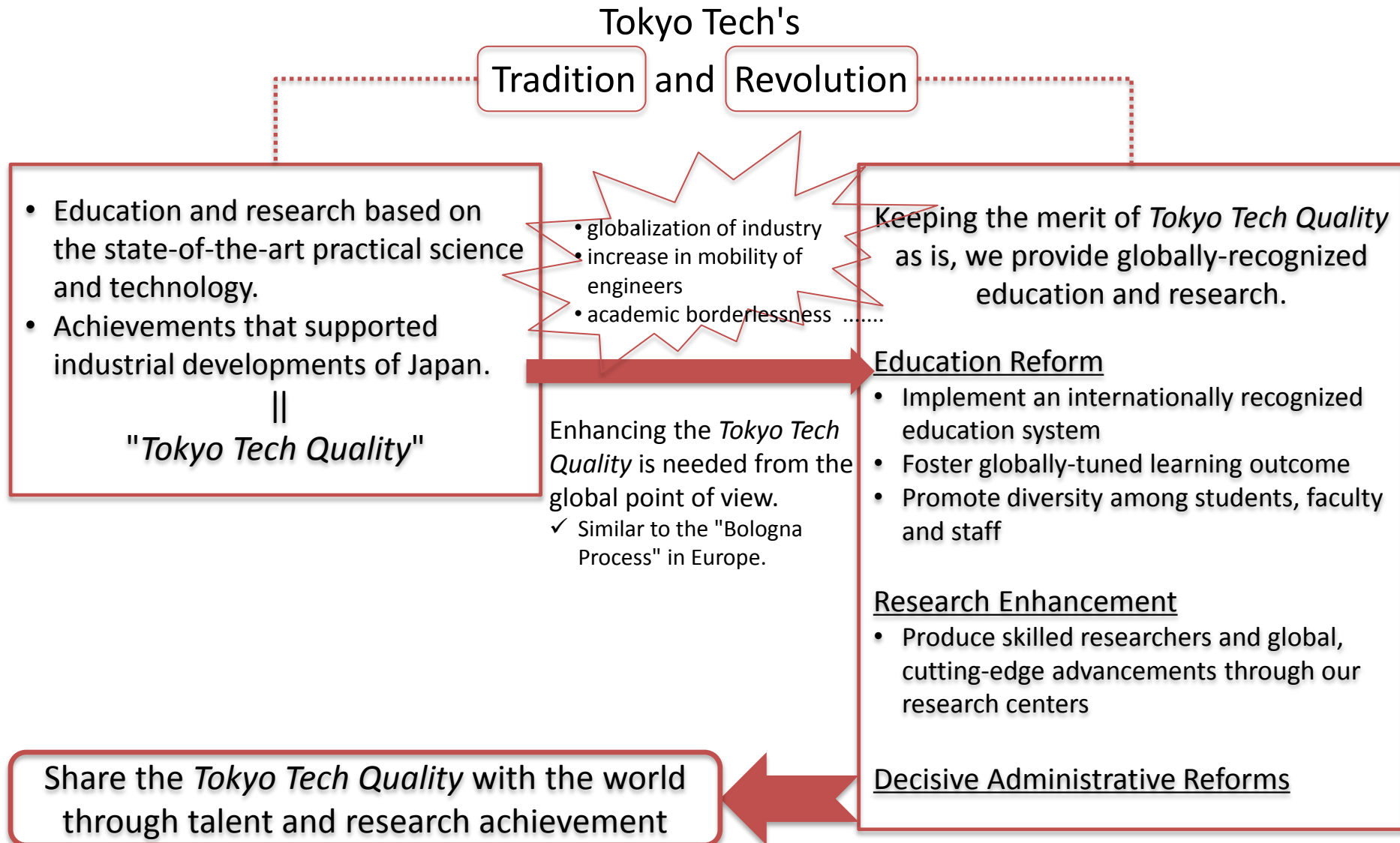

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Action Plans

Global Innovation in the Education System:

Assurance of an internationally-recognized education

- Academic tuning for easier credit transfer among world-wide universities.
- International dissemination of education information.
- Acquisition of international accreditations (EURO-ACE, JABEE, etc.).

Global Innovation in Research activities:

Establish research centers modeled after the Earth-Life Science Institute (ELSI), Tokyo Tech's WPI project. (<http://www.elsi.jp/en/>)

Provide graduate education at the world's most advanced research hub.

Administrative Reforms to Promote Internationalization:

Personnel

- Aggressive investment in personnel for target fields.

Space and Infrastructure

- Implementation of a world-class education and research environment.

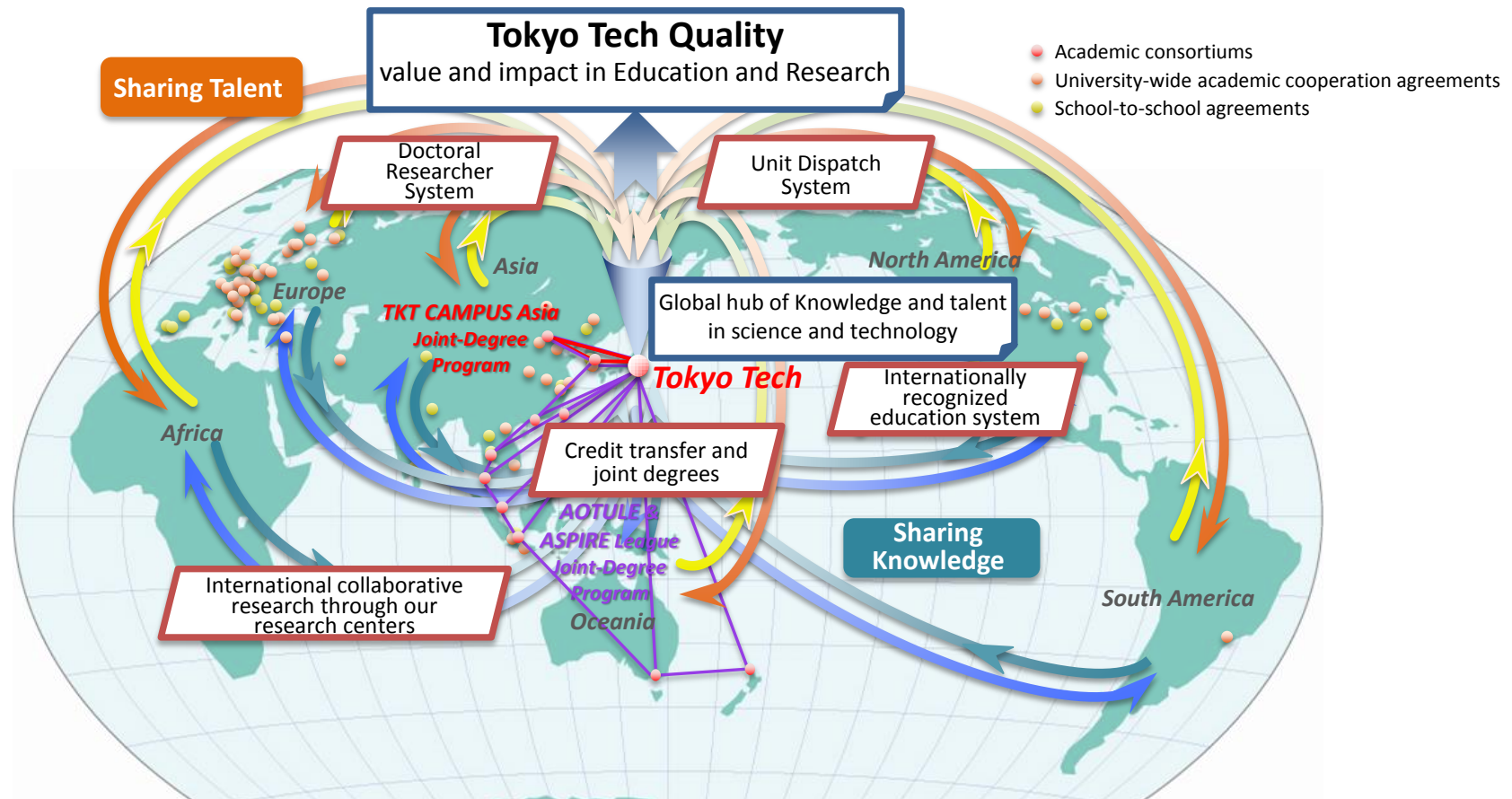
Finance
