

TAIST-Tokyo Tech (joint graduate education program)



Tokyo Tech cooperates with NSTDA of Thailand and leading Thai universities in the administration of Thailand Advanced Institute of Science and Technology (TAIST)-Tokyo Tech, a jointly organized graduate education program intended to serve as a hub for human resources development in science and technology in Thailand. Established in 2007, TAIST-Tokyo Tech offers 3 programs (A2TE, AIoT, SERE) and 1 optional curriculum (RT), and graduates approximately 50 students each year.

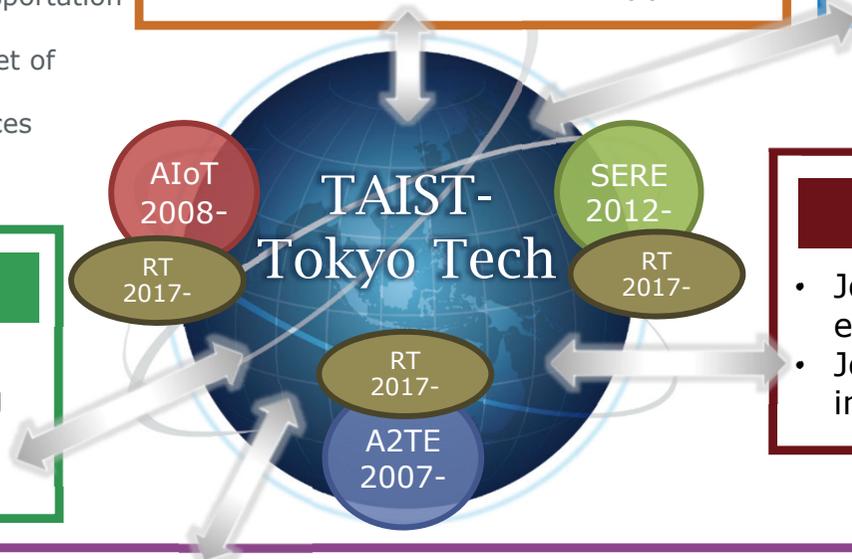
