Art with an artist 2023 Fall held at Ookayama Campus

The in-person version of the Art with an Artist seminar with painter and poet Zuse Meyer returned to Tokyo Tech on November 15, taking place on Ookayama Campus for the first time. Twenty from diverse backgrounds - ten are Japanese and ten are international students --participated in the event to gain new perspectives while discovering themselves through creative ways of expression.

The Student Support Center's Student Success Support Section, which hosts the event every spring and fall, welcomed back Zuse Meyer, who is a graduate of the Berlin University of the Arts and a former lecturer at the Institute. Joining the participants, roughly half of whom were master's program international students, another half was under graduate students. It was a great opportunity to interact or students from various background.

Artist Zuse Meyer(Painter and poet)

A graduate of the Berlin University of the Arts, painter and poet, Meyer is a former lecturer at Tokyo Tech. She is currently based in both Berlin and Tokyo for conducting creative activities, and runs an art school and art workshops in both Europe and Asia

As it is tradition, the event included a lecture by Meyer followed by a hands-on session of sketching by the students. After that, Meyer gave feedback to every student.



Part1 Lecture - HumanBeing and Space

The theme of this seminar was "Human Being and Space." In the lecture Meyer showed European paintings from 16th to 20th century as examples how in all centuries the masters used human figures and space to express certain narratives and to create atmosphere. The single figures were not just objects in a specific architecture, but through skillful use of color, perspective etc, expressing the emotions of the depicted beings, space and humans form an active relationship. Meyer explained the essential vital elements of the paintings and their meaning and power.

Part2 Practice session

Warm-up activity: Single-stroke sketching

To warm up, students were requested to create a sketch using only one ongoing single pencil line. On small sketch papers, the students practiced drawing people around them in one continuous stroke. Ms. Meyer said, "If your hand stop, hesitation might arise. It is important to keep just drawing. The students obtained new experience from this practice.

The next task was to draw people on a larger sketch paper with the non-dominant hand. "Your dominant hand is always thinking and tries to control. Try to draw according to your own intuition and sensitivities with the non-dominant hand." With warm encouragement from Ms. Meyer, each student completed a unique work.


