※Please note that if you do not take the medical checkup:

- You will be asked to take the medical checkup at your own expense at a nearby medical institution and submit the results to the Health Support Center.
- You will not be able to receive your medical certificate issued by the university.

- Eligible Persons : Newly enrolled bachelor's degree students in 2022
- Place : Health Support Center (Ookayama)
- Medical certificate : The results will be available from the end of April.
- Students will be able to see the results on the web system for student and faculty starting mid-May. Only those who need a further examination will be personally informed.
- If you have symptoms like fever and cough, DO NOT come to take the medical checkup. Instead, please call the Health Support Center at the number below.



* Medical checkup includes

- Measurements(height, weight)
- Urine test
- Eyesight check
- Blood pressure test
- Chest x-ray examination
- Web questionnaires (Advance input)

* One's belongings

- Medical questionnaire form
(Fill out the form in advance. **Student ID number required**)
- Urine sample
- Wear or bring a plain T-shirt
(DO NOT wear clothes with buttons)
- Wear a mask (Non-woven mask)
- Bring a hair band (for those with long hair)
