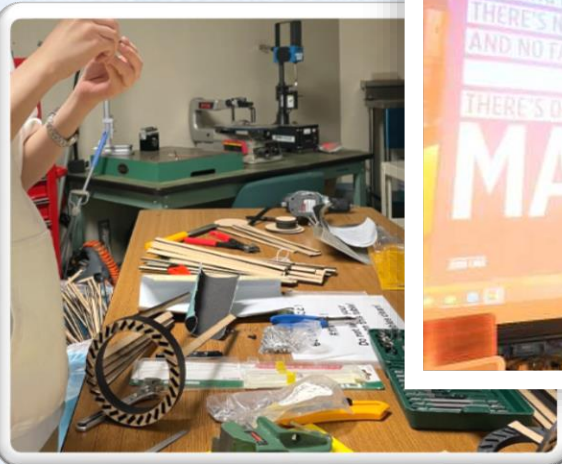
5-day international workshop for undergraduates

Screening method: Document review (and/or assignment submission)

Course registration: Students who pass the on-campus screening may register and receive 2 credits from the International Engineering Design Experiences (Spring Semester) (course code TSE.A342).

The course credits can be counted toward “Study Abroad or International Internship Program (P4)” Global Scientists and Engineers Course completion requirements.
