

# Application Guideline for Seasonal Program offered by Tokyo Tech Partner Universities

Students participating in summer/winter programs offered by Tokyo Tech's partner universities are supported by scholarships, procedural assistance and credits. The timing and duration vary according to the partner universities, but program lasting from 2 to 12 weeks from May to September 2024 are eligible. The program includes coursework and research projects.

Students must consult and obtain the consent of their family, guarantor and academic advisor before participating in the program.

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1. Outline This offer provides scholarships, procedural support and credits to participants in summer/winter programs organized by partner universities. The applicant (participant) is responsible for applying to the program, arranging airline tickets and accommodation, and completing the travel procedures.

## 2. Details of Support

(1) Scholarship (with eligibility requirements)

The program period (not including the time required for departure, travel, and return) is divided into 31-day periods, and the following amounts are provided per grant period.

Leibniz University Hannover, Technical University of Denmark, Linköping University, École nationale des ponts et chaussées, University of California, Berkeley, RWTH Aachen University, University of Oxford, Technische Universität Berlin: 80,000 yen  
The Hong Kong University of Science and Technology: 70,000 yen  
University College London, Nanyang Technological University: 100,000 yen

However, students studying in the U.K. may be eligible for the Tazaki Foundation Scholarship for Study in the U.K. For details, please refer to the course details.

(2) Procedural Support

Students who are unfamiliar with English websites can apply to the Study Abroad Information Center for assistance with the application process.

## 3. Target Period

May 2024 - September 2024

Some of the programs may fall during the period of Tokyo Tech's classes and examinations, so please carefully check the curriculum of your department to make sure there are no obstacles to your participation in the program.

## 6. 応募資格

- 1) Bachelor's and master's degree students who are enrolled in a regular course at Tokyo Tech at the time of application and study abroad \*1
- 2) Students who will return to Tokyo Tech after their study abroad period to continue their studies or obtain a degree.
- 3) Students who meet the requirements of each program, such as academic year, affiliation, and field of specialization.
- 4) Applicants must have a certain level of English proficiency (TOEIC score of 550, TOEFL ITP score of 490, or TOEFL iBT score of 57) in order to take classes and live in the host country using English. However, if the participating program has a higher language requirement, the student must meet that standard.
- 5) Students who will receive credits for their achievements after completing the program\*2 For the possible credits, please refer to "11.
- 6) Applicants for "2. Support 1) Scholarship" must meet the following qualifications
  - A) Japanese nationals, permanent residents of Japan, and international students other than those receiving a MEXT Scholarship.
  - B) The applicant's grades for the previous year based on the calculation of the "Calculation Method for Grading Factors" have an evaluation coefficient of 2.30 or higher\*3.
  - C) Applicants who are unable to participate in the program solely at their own expense due to financial reasons (in principle, those who meet the "4 Family Finances Criteria"). Regardless of whether the applicant meets the criteria or not, he/she will be asked to submit an application form on his/her family's financial situation after passing the selection process).

※1 Some programs have a separate grade limit. In addition, as a rule, international students are not allowed to study in their home countries.

2 Those who will graduate from an undergraduate program or complete a graduate program in September 2024 and participate in a program that ends in August or later will not be eligible for scholarships or credits because they will not receive them in time

to receive them, but they will be eligible for procedural support and orientation.

3 Calculation method of the grading scale: The grades of the previous year are converted into "grading points" according to the following table and calculated by applying the formula (rounded off to two decimal places). Students with a grade point average of less than 2.3 are eligible to receive support other than the scholarship described in "2) Support" in "2."

Approval (signature and seal on the application form) by an academic advisor (1st-3rd year of undergraduates) and academic supervisor (4th year of bachelor's program or above) is required to apply. Please prepare your application well in advance. The above submission deadlines are the application deadlines for Tokyo Tech. Please refer to the website of each partner institution for application deadlines and documents to be submitted. International students should confirm the visa period, conditions, etc. of the destination country in advance.

Applications with incomplete documents or submitted after the above deadlines will not be accepted.

- 1) After being selected to participate in the program, participants are required to attend an orientation session to explain the documents to be submitted and the procedures to be followed.
- 2) Be sure to purchase overseas travel insurance (including risk management services) as specified by Tokyo Tech.
- 3) After participating in the program, if requested by the Study Abroad Information Center, you are expected to make presentations at study abroad events, publicize your study abroad experience, and cooperate in various surveys and questionnaires regarding the results of your study abroad experience as much as possible.
- 4) After returning to Japan, the student must submit a written report (in Japanese for undergraduate students and in English for master's students) and other necessary documents to the Study Abroad Information Center, and participate in a debriefing session to receive credit.
- 5) The following credits can be earned. For details, please refer to the syllabus.  
Credit for study abroad provided by the Center for Entrepreneurship Education (courses to be taken will be announced at the orientation session).  
Credit may also be granted for courses offered by the department/course to which the student belongs.  
If you wish to receive credits for courses related to overseas study at your department/course, please contact the instructor in charge of the course directly.
