3. Fees and Scholarships

There are no registration or participation fees. Participants should cover travel costs, overseas travel insurance, transportation, other personal activities during the program. A stipend to cover some expenses may be provided by Tokyo Tech after returning to Japan. The students who receive financial aid from programs that do not permit funding from other sources (e.g., recipients of MEXT Scholarship students, recipients of overseas government scholarships, etc.) are not eligible.

(2) Copy of Official Transcripts

*A copy of your GRADES LIST from the Tokyo Tech Web System is acceptable. M1 students and D1 students are required to submit their transcripts from the previous course.

(3) Certification of English language ability

*Certification is not required of IGP student

- Complete your final Online application through IDEA League Website by **June 12, 2023**. IDEA League registration website (sirop) : <u>https://sirop.org/app/register</u>
- Submit your completion report to our group after participating this summer school.

(2) All Tokyo Tech Students traveling abroad must submit an overseas travel notice (海外渡航届), and a departure notice (出発届) without exception.

These procedures basically asked to complete through *Tokyo Tech Application Submission System (T2APPs)*. If you are not able to complete the submission on T2APPs, please consult Tokyo Tech Student Division to submit the documents.

(3) The student must purchase overseas travel insurance specified by Tokyo Tech (coverage must be at least 30 million yen for medical treatment and rescue expenses and at least 100 million yen for personal liability).

(4) After returning to their home country, you must cooperate in study abroad debriefing sessions and study abroad fairs if you are asked to.

(5) International students

International students may be required to obtain a visa.

After receiving a notification of nomination from Tokyo Tech, you should immediately contact the Embassy of respective country (the Netherlands / Germany) in Japan to find out if you need to apply for a visa.

If a visa is required, you must apply for the visa yourself.

Please understand that you will not be able to participate in this program if you cannot obtain a visa in time for your departure date.
