In cooperation with Imperial College London ("Imperial"), Tokyo Tech invites student applications for **Imperial-Tokyo Tech Global Fellows Programme 2024***, a weeklong, training camp-style professional program that will bring together Imperial and Tokyo Tech doctoral students from various disciplines for collaboration around the theme of Good health and Well-being.

Good health and Well-being is identified as one of the UN's 17 Sustainable Development Goals. Hosted by Imperial, participants will gather in London to develop the professional, research and collaborative skills necessary to find workable solutions to the problems of SDG 3 and its impacts. Through team discussions and interaction with researchers from different disciplines, development of collaborative research, participation in site visits, and poster presentations, Global Fellows will enhance their leadership and communication skills, further develop their interdisciplinary and intercultural awareness, and build professional networks.

Tokyo Tech doctoral students from across the Institute are invited to submit an application.

* The Global Fellows Programme is a doctoral student exchange program. It is based on Imperial College London's Global Fellows Programme of and is organized under Tokyo Tech's Institute for Liberal Arts' courses for doctoral students.

- 1. Tokyo Tech doctoral students. Students of all nationalities, departments and majors are eligible to apply. The program is not open to those in non-degree or exchange programs at Tokyo Tech.
- 2. In principle, applicants should not have participated in the Global Fellows Programme previously.

Selection Process:

Participants will be competitively selected on the basis of their applications. Interviews may be conducted if a large number of applications is received.

Scholarship:

Participants may receive a stipend of approximately 80,000 yen to offset expenses.

*MEXT scholarship students are not eligible.

*If currently receiving any scholarship, please confirm with the scholarship granting institution regarding the possibility of co-subsidizing with another scholarship.

Expenses:

- 1) Roundtrip airfare between Tokyo and London.
 - Participants will purchase their own tickets, so the cost may vary depending on the airline and ticket purchase dates.
 - Those receiving a stipend may use it to cover part or all of the cost of their airfare.
- 2) Enrollment in overseas travel insurance. The cost is approximately 5,000 yen.
- 3) Personal expenses.

Note: Meals (Breakfast and Lunch) and accommodation during the programme will be provided free of charge.

Course Credit:

Those selected for the programme should register for LAH.C617, Global Camp 1. Participants can receive two credits for the course after successful completion of the programme. (Details will be informed when course registration becomes available.)

Other:

Those selected for the programme are expected to participate in the Predeparture Orientation. Details will be provided after programme selection is completed. English lessons would be offered for those who wish to strengthen their discussion skills in English before going to the UK.

Research Activities at Imperial

Applicants can stay at Imperial for one to three months, engage in research activities in a laboratory of their choice. You will need to find your own host laboratory.

Duration: 1-3 months between September 2024 and March 2025.

Scholarship: Students may apply for the Tazaki Foundation Scholarship for Study in the UK.

(There are requirements for the scholarship, but this is not a decision).

MEXT students are not eligible for the scholarship.
