

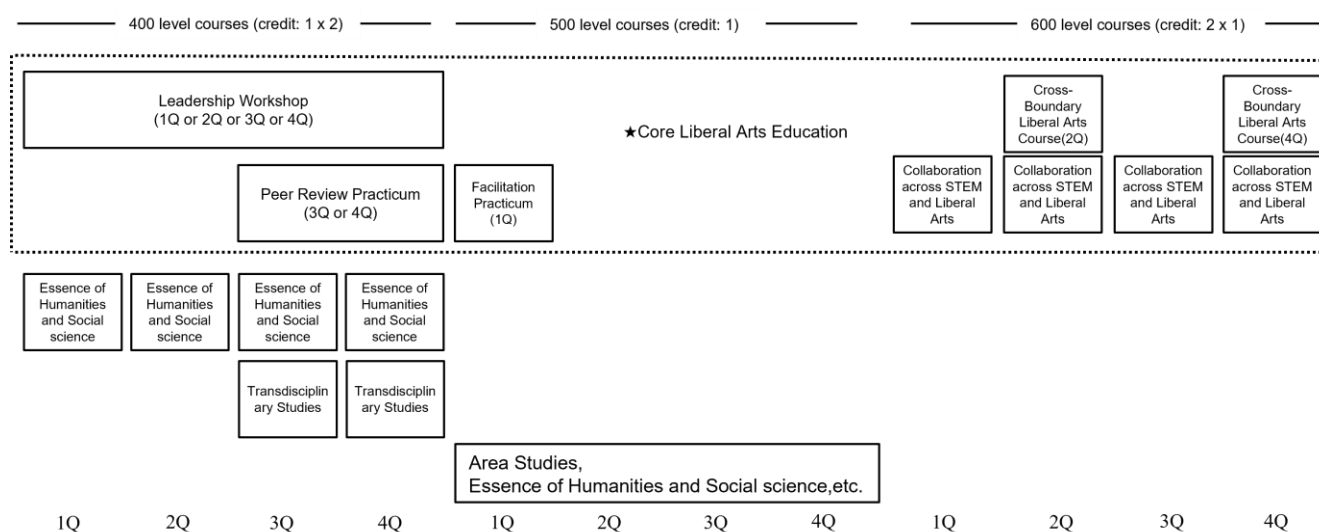
Humanities and Social Science Courses

Among issues that happen in the real world, none can be solved by only one academic discipline. In order to make use of your expertise in everyday life, no matter how advanced your knowledge is, you have to have practical abilities such as taking leadership through engaging with others, having holistic view about the position of your expertise in the world of academia, and acquiring knowledge about social and cultural backgrounds of many areas of the world. Our Humanities and Social Science courses in the master's and doctoral degree program aim to foster these practical abilities and knowledge with “humanity”, “social skills” and “creativity” at the core. The classes themselves are valuable opportunities to interact with students who have diverse academic backgrounds.

Overview of the Curriculum System

Our Institute's “Wedge-shaped Style Education” enables students to pursue liberal arts education in a phased manner throughout undergraduate and graduate programs. Students are encouraged to take 100-level to 600-level courses in order. As such, master's students must begin Humanities and Social Science courses at the 400 level (in 1Q/2Q of the first year for those entered in April, and 3Q/4Q for those entered in September), then proceed to 500-level courses (in 3Q/4Q or later for those entered in April, and 1Q/2Q of the following year or later for those entered in September).

Humanities and Social Science courses are divided into the following categories. There are one or more courses with different content in one category. All are electives. Students can take more than one course from one category.



Notes about Taking Humanities and Social Science Courses:

■ In the master's degree program, Humanities and Social Science courses have a “pre-registration” system. Before classes start, students are asked to pre-register their desired courses, then placed in courses in accordance with the capacity of each course. Pre-registrations can be done twice a year (before 1Q & 2Q and 3Q & 4Q). Please note that the details will be announced at the guidances and by emails. Emails will be sent to “...@m.titech.ac.jp” addresses.

■ In the doctoral degree program, there is no “pre-registration” system. Should the number of applicants exceed the limit, however, a lottery system may be used to determine which students are admitted. Please check the syllabi for details. Also

please note that important notices, including the lottery results (if a lottery system is used), will be sent by email to the address provided by our Institute.

Students who enrolled in AY2022 or later cannot take “Collaboration across STEM and Liberal Arts” Courses marked with [1] (1 credit courses). One-credit courses can only be taken by students who have taken at least one course (and earned one credit) in Humanities and Social Science courses* by AY2021. (*Examples: Path-Breaking Liberal Arts Courses 1A–4A, Independent Studies Courses 1A–4A, and Glocal Doctor Courses Y1–Y4.) Students admitted in or before AY2021 who have not completed a 600-level Humanities and Social Science course — as well as students who enrolled in AY2022 or later — should take the two-credit courses.

<For International Students>

Japanese Language and Culture Courses offered to international students can be recognized as equivalent to the Humanities and Social Science Courses of the corresponding course level.
