At the 10th AEARU Workshop on Computer Science and Web Technology to be hosted by the University of Tsukuba, we plan to focus on the following topics such as:


- Cloud computing

Student participants are required to obtain permission for application from their supervisors whose names and mail addresses should be provided. All inquiries can be sent to the same e-mail address as well.

Notification of Acceptance

We accept at most one presentation per author, although he/she may coauthor multiple abstracts. Notification of acceptance will be sent to presenters on **December 15**, **2014.** Accepted authors are then requested to submit the camera-ready abstracts using the same template by January 16, 2015.

Abstract Booklet

All abstracts of oral and poster presentations will be compiled into a booklet and distributed to the participants in the workshop. Please do not include any protected, proprietary, confidential, or patented information since the copyright is not protected.
