






'Self-assembly of semiaromatic poly(amic acid) into flower-like microparticles via one-step precipitation polymerization'





How can I get a SIM card in Japan?

✓ Passport

- ✓ Residence card(在留カード)<u>with address</u>
- ✓ Cash card or credit card
- ✓ Signature stamp(印鑑)











How can I create a bank account?



To pay the tuition, rent, utilities, etc.

- Check the business hour! (Weekdays, 9am-3pm)
- Find the near your home or the campus
- Reservation is needed for opening a bank account.
- Nonresistant for the first half year.
- Bring your signature stamp!!!
- Only in Japanese

Monthly rent/Deposit/Gratitude Mansion/Apāto

*The overall process could take up

- <u>at least 2 weeks.</u>
 - *The initial cost may cost as 4-5
- times as your monthly rent.

Things to do at the local ward office

- Find your local ward office: Ōta-ku, Meguro-ku, Setagaya-ku, etc.
- Resident Registration
- National Health Insurance Registration

* National Pension System

In Japan, all residents over 20 years old must join the National Pension system. However, people who have not earned any income in Japan during the previous year are eligible for an exemption. In which case, please follow the instructions of the ward/city office staff and complete the necessary procedures.
