Overview of the program and the host university/organization abroad

The AEARU Summer Institute of Flipped Education 2023 was hosted by Hong Kong University of Science and Technology in Hong Kong as a one-week exchange program. This social science masterclass yielded a deeper and profound understanding of China. In addition to this the participants were introduced to a large part of the history of Hong Kong through sightseeing, museum visits, and restaurant visits.

When it came to obtaining information relevant to the study abroad, most of the necessary information was provided by the International Engagement Division and the facilitators at HKUST. They were very supportive, and quick at responding to questions. In short, the pre-departure preparation consisted of paying for the accommodation at HKUST which HKUST helped me with, getting a travel insurance through HKUST, getting a travel insurance through Tokyo Tech, and lastly buying the plane tickets to and from Hong Kong. For some people it will be necessary to apply for a visa, but I didn't need to apply for it.

The social science masterclass is about Understanding China: 1700-2000 through big data. This class utilized something called flipped education, meaning that the homework was to understand the preparation materials associated with each lecture. Each lecture two groups had a presentation about the theme of the lecture. Two other groups were responsible for asking some starter questions, facilitating the discussions.

There were classes every day 10:00-12:50. Beside that we had a packed schedule the rest of days. The first day there was a typhoon of degree 8, meaning lectures couldn't go according to plan. Instead, we got invited to the Professor's home for lunch. Later that day we also had a welcome dinner at one of the restaurants at campus with a three-course meal. The other days went according to plan. To experience and explore Hong Kong I believe the activities we had greatly enhanced it. The activities were: visit to Tai Kwun, Hong Kong palace Museum, M+, 1881, Tsim Sha Tsui, boat trip with the old red sailboat «Duckling» in the Hong Kong Bay, eating at a michelin seafood restaurant in Sai Kung, visit to the Hong Kong Monetary

Authority, and take the ferris wheel in Central. We also had many lunches together, as well as free time in the afternoons and weekend to sightsee on our own.

The study abroad expenses for this program are very acceptable: the accommodation at HKUST were 1000 HKD (18 000 yen), for the airplane tickets I paid around 3900 HKD (70 000 yen), the Tokyo Tech insurance ended up at around 4000 yen, and the HKUST ended up at 4500 yen. Do note that Hong Kong is a bit more expensive than Japan. I did not receive a scholarship.

The accommodation provided by HKUST were incredible. The dorm was located on the Campus area, approximately 10 minutes of walking to the lecture hall, and had a nice ocean view as the university is located by the ocean. The exchange program participants were situated all on the same floor of a dorm complex with shared toilets and showers. In the rooms two and two people lived together, though the rooms were large. The common room was particularly interesting as one could work, talk, and have social events there. It was very social. Both female and men were located on the same floor.
