1. Outline

The Renault Foundation offers students financial aid, for example, accommodation, tuition and transportation costs. - ① Managing Digital Transformation & Innovation Advanced Master (BY SMIB)
- ② Electric Vehicles and Autonomous Vehicles Specialized Master's Degree (EV-AV)
- ③ Master's Degree Transport and Sustainable Development (TRADD)

2. Date

Approximately 12-16 months from Autumn 2019, depending on the program.

- ① BY SMIB: Approximately 16 months
- ② EV-AV: Approximately 12 months
- ③ TRADD: Approximately 13 months

4. Requirements

· Regular students (in degree programs) or graduates who have a Bachelor's degree or above from Tokyo Tech as of the beginning of this program.

· Under 35 as of September 2019.

· Meet all application requirements for each program.

- * Students need to pass an interview test which will be conducted by The Renault Foundation after recommendation from Tokyo Tech. The interview test will be held online.
- * Even if you do not meet the language requirements, you may be nominated for the application. In that case, please consult with International Student Exchange Division by **11am, January 15, 2019.**
- * Students taking a leave of absence from Tokyo Tech are basically ineligible to apply. Please consult with the International Student Exchange Division in advance if you wish to apply.
